**2. CHARITY FLAT RACE – Sunday 11 March 2012**

Following the success of our previous three charity races, UCSW is organising another charity race which will be held at **Warwick Racecourse on Sunday 11 March, 2012** at the end of their “Countryside Day”.

**Might you, or someone you know, be interested in taking part?** It is a great opportunity for someone who either wants the thrill of racing or who is just starting out on his/her career in racing....

**Race Rules (in brief – more information available from UCSW):**

- There will be a maximum of 12 runners
- The flat race will be run under British Horseracing Authority Rules held over approx 1m 4f on the grass track
- The weight to be carried will be a minimum of 12 stone
- To comply with regulations, riders may have to participate in a training course (to be financed by the rider). Those exempt from this include professional hunt staff and stable staff, who must present written confirmation from their employer that they ride out on a regular basis
- Riders must be over the age of 16 to participate
- To qualify, all riders need to raise a minimum of £500
